For your own protection, we recommend that you purchase an “auto-pak” with third party liability limits of at least \$2,000,000.

School Division Automobile Liability Insurance

Excess automobile third party liability insurance protection is provided for the volunteer driver by the Board’s insurance program while the vehicle is being driven for an approved school activity or function. This insurance is in excess of the limit/coverage provided by the vehicle owner’s license plates and package policy.

Thank you for volunteering to drive students to a school event. The cost of busing would make it impossible for schools to participate in many activities outside of the school. Your help opens up opportunities for our students to compete with other schools in various athletic events, visit educational sites and exhibits, as well as enjoy community events and performances.



Our intent, through the introduction of the Automobile Driver Authorization, is to enhance the safety of all our students.

Each and every parent volunteer driver will be required to complete the Automobile Driver Authorization.

The Authorization form will be kept confidential and will remain with the principal for office use only.

Please notify the school principal with any changes to the Authorization form that may occur during the school year.

*You need to complete this form **only once for each vehicle** you use to transport students.*

Please read carefully:

- No child shall be placed in a seat where an air bag is located.
- Children who weigh less than 40 lbs. must use a properly installed CMVS approved child seat.
- It is recommended that children who weigh between 40 lbs. and 60 lbs. must use a CMVS approved child booster seat.
